## Dear Senators and Representatives:

On behalf of law enforcement officers within the State of Alabama, the undersigned Sheriffs and Chiefs of Police write to support Senate Bill 143 (by Sen. Will Barfoot of Montgomery) and House Bill 191 (by Rep. Allen Treadaway of Birmingham). We call upon the Legislature to expeditiously consider and pass this important tool in combating the rise of gang activity in our communities. Gang violence is a cancer and tough sentences are the antidote.

Currently, Alabama has no law on the books to specifically combat or deter gang activity and gang violence. Borrowing from the laws of several states and the United States Code, Senate Bill 143 and House Bill 191 will ensure that the punishments for crimes committed in the name of a gang and gang-related activities involving firearms are both certain and severe.

First, any felony committed to promote the interests of a gang will be automatically enhanced to the next highest offense level. We know that gang activity spreads with criminal acts designed to benefit the gang, and automatic enhancements will help stem its expansion.

Second, any use of a firearm intended to promote gang activity will be met with tough mandatory sentences. Gang-related gunplay will result in no less than five years and up to thirty years mandatory imprisonment. Plus, sentences for gang-related gunplay must run *consecutively* to any other related term of imprisonment. We applaud legislation that finally recognizes, and duly punishes, senseless gun crime that is so often tied to gang-related conflict.

Finally, juveniles who commit adult crime must do adult time. This bill recognizes the undeniable connection between juvenile delinquency and gang activity. No longer can gangs be allowed to recruit younger and younger members in the hope that juveniles will escape punishment for their adult crimes. Thus, anyone sixteen years of age or older, charged under this statute, will automatically be certified as an adult, and serve adult time for adult crime.

In sum, our communities have had enough. We must refuse to succumb to the swell of gang-related crime that is plaguing so many cities and states in our nation. It is time to reinvigorate the rule of law and hold gang members accountable for their actions. This legislation does exactly that. We urge your swift enactment of Senate Bill 143 and House Bill 191.
